
Your Christmas gift will enable us to immunise Pacific babies against life-threatening childhood diseases and protect young girls and women from the scourge of cervical cancer.

Parliamentarian Zali Steggall OAM will be the guest speaker at Sydney Rotary Club's lunchtime meeting on Tuesday **15th December**.

Born in Manly and from a sporting family , Zali represented Australia at four Winter Olympic Games from 1992 to 2002.

She completed a degree after retiring from sport and worked as a barrister. She was honoured with an Order of Australia Medal in 2007 for contributions to sport and charity.

In January 2019, Zali announced her candidacy as an independent for Warringah and went on to win that seat in the Federal Election in May, 2019.

90th Anniversary President's Project



Arinex founder and chair, Roslyn McLeod OAM became President of the Rotary Club of Sydney for the term of 2010-11 and selected as her President's project the Children's Medical Research Institute under the guidance of Director and Head of CMRI's Cancer Research, Professor Roger Reddel. Rotary raised \$170,000 for the CMRI to support CMRI's Cancer Research and Gene Therapy Research Units.

Ten years on, Professor Reddel has been named in the top 2% of globally cited researchers in the recent Clarivate Highly Cited Researchers 2020 list of Most highly cited academics by subject areas 1996 – 2018, and he tells us how the funds raised have contributed to some of the key
